Prof. Victor V. Claar teaches economics at Florida Gulf Coast University, where he holds the BB&T Distinguished Professorship in Free Enterprise. He is also an affiliate scholar of the Acton Institute. Professor Claar has a long, impressive record of publications, including his influential book, Economics in Christian Perspective, now in its tenth printing and recently translated into Chinese. He also coauthored Fair Trade? Its Prospects as a Poverty Solution (Acton Institute) and the forthcoming book, The Keynesian Revolution and the Rise of Economic Materialism (Palgrave Macmillan). Professor Claar is a Fulbright Scholar, having spent a year teaching economics to graduate students in the former-Soviet republic of Armenia. He earned his Ph.D. in economics at West Virginia University.
